ASX ANNOUNCEMENT

Over the last 2 months Phoslock Water Solutions (PWS) has completed four applications totaling over 150 tons in Australia, South East Asia and UK.

The application to the **Canning River in Western Australia** was previously reported and received widespread media coverage given the support of both the Western Australian Minister of Water, the Honorable Dr Graham Jacobs and the Minister for Environment, the Honorable Donna Faragher.

A 30 second Channel Ten news item on the Canning River application went to air on Thursday 18th February. This clip will shortly be posted on the phoslock.com.au website.

A second application of a similar size to that of the Canning River was applied in **Water Ski Park in southern Perth, Western Australia**, which has had long standing water quality issues. PWS treated a Brisbane water ski park in early 2009 which has proved very successful, with major short and long term improvements to the water quality. 14 months later, excellent water quality has been maintained despite being used by hundreds of people each week.

Phoslock is currently being extensively trialed in a **major South East Asian city** to be used on canals leading into a large reservoir and on the drinking water reservoir itself. The trial is being done on full commercial terms. Attached is a photo from a recent trial application.



A 25 tonne application was also completed last week on a shallow loch near **Inverness in Scotland**. The loch has a long and well documented history of cultural eutrophication and is a designated site of Special Scientific Interest in the UK due to

its use as a nesting site by the rare Slovenian Grebe and its population of great crested newts.

The application was an initiative of the UK's Centre for Ecology and Hydrology and forms part of a project aimed at accelerating the recovery of eutrophic shallow lakes using Phoslock. The application was undertaken by Phoslock Europe.

A series of similar applications are planned for the UK and Europe during summer and autumn 2010.

PWS has received an order for a 12 ton project in **Tianjin, China**, which is scheduled to be applied in early April. This is an important project as it is being run in conjunction with a leading Water Institute in China and the results will get widespread distribution.

PWS is currently awaiting ice to melt for a major application to take place in early April in **Canada**. Product and application machinery is on site and ready for application.

With major changes in the **United States** to approvals of products suitable for applications for use on open water bodies, PWS has received a flood of enquiries on various projects looking to use an environmental friendly product like Phoslock. The company is applying significant resources working with local parties on these projects.
